Media Plays a Role in Water Diplomacy



Water diplomacy recognizes that there are many different actors that have the ability to create solution spaces for conflicts over water and that can create windows of opportunity for cooperation over water. These actors are inclusive of government officials (state and local level), non-state/government actors, private sector, civil society, media, and others.

Where *water diplomacy* supports *transboundary water cooperation*- journalists may play a critical role in highlighting and contextualizing the numerous benefits to cooperation

Lessons Learned



- Many issues central to cooperation in the Nile are sensitive amongst countries but good balanced journalism can inform without encroachment (strengthening the enabling environment for cooperation)
- Journalists face diverse challenges outside of the complicated story of cooperationsupport must be creative and reflective
- Journalists and decision makers need each other- cooperation in demand across the board
- Fake news and targeted disinformation campaigns are only becoming more frequentsupporting good journalists and providing more opportunity for their reflection helps cut through (Real recognizes real)
