

Strategic alignment of SDG vs. Climate character character in Local Government Authorities

- Achieving the targets in the Sustainable Development Goals (SDGs) requires integration, coherence as climate change raises a critical test to transboundary water resource management in the Nile Basin.
- <u>Subsidiarity</u> = "<u>Decentralization by Devolution</u>",a common governance theme, is an <u>opportunity</u> for engaging local Government Authorities in the basin to minimize risks associated with Climate change
- A cross sectional study (2022) to characterize the SDGs localization vs. Climate change mainstreaming in 42 subnational Government Authorities interfacing Lake









Topline study findings



- Low institutional competence for intersecting SDGs and climate change in Local Government Authorities
- Limited methodological understanding of climate change vs.
 SDGs.
- Only 12% subnational authorities participated in SDG-VNR, with 19% having integrated plans for mainstreaming climate change into annual development plans.
- About 10% confirmed to have benefited from devolved climate finance and 10% demonstrated explicit investments on climate-smart interventions at community level.













Findings on LGAs participation in SDG VNR and CCA plans

LGAs with explicit Climate change adaptation plans







Findings on devolved CCA finance and investments

- Promoting <u>innovative transboundary dialogues</u> for climate resilience in the basin with enlarged space for subnational authorities
- Strengthening competence-based understanding on mainstreaming climate change in subnational governance structures within the Nile Co-operation frameworks alongside guiding a roadmap for climate finance devolution
