





- •The demand for surface water across many basins in the world is growing, calling for alternative sources of water.
- •One target area is the groundwater.
- •Indigenous peoples are more affected negatively by this increased demand.











- The population in both Kagera and Elgon sub-regions are predominantly an agricultural society, therefore need more water.
- Because of their perceived low social and economic status in society, Indigenous peoples have limited access to: governance and management of natural resources/ water; access to adequate ground water

- Lack of/low self esteem
- •They are used as cheap labour (Kagera)
- •Elite capture
- •"systematic discrimination and marginalization"
